EBC Mission Focus Prayer sheet October 2017

Worldwide

Baptist Missionary Society – workers and partners from BMS strive to make Jesus known and share the full life He brings through various services in over 35 countries.

Prayer points: *pray into the key ministry areas for BMS: Justice, Development, Education, Health, Church, Leadership, and Relief. Pray that BMS workers will have wisdom to share God's love in their specific contexts.*

Compassion – A child advocacy ministry that works to bring children out of poverty and help them grow into responsible, fulfilled Christian adults. Ablaze sponsor Nazaire who lives in Burkina Faso.

Prayer points: *Pray that Nazaire continues to grow as a disciple, that his passion for Jesus would be infectious in his family and community. Pray for his education and health.*

Bridge of Hope Children's Ministry – supports orphans and abandoned children in West Uganda through providing homely environments, meals, health and spiritual care and education.

Prayer points: *Pray for God's blessing on all the teaches, workers, and children linked to the BoHCM homes, nursery and school. Pray for God's blessing and wisdom to share God's love to neighbouring and rural communities with projects to provide clean water and family support.*

Enfair – helps women in extreme poverty in India to gain confidence and hope for their future through teaching them new skills such as sewing and embroidery. Items made give these women a much-needed income.
