## FUNDING FOR OPERATIONS MANAGER

At the January Church Meeting, the need for a full-time **Operations Manager** was presented and it was agreed that EBC would seek to appoint to this post subject to adequate funding being in place.

We now need the financial support of the church to take this forward. The salary for this role is expected to be £30,000 per year, which including employer costs to EBC equates to £3,200 per month.

This amount needs to be found by additional/increased giving on a regular basis. We therefore need to ascertain that the church collectively is able to meet this financial commitment, which is over and above the additional giving required for the 2018 budget.
